



Competitions, bloodline presentations and auction sales, **more than 600 cattle of 12 different breeds** will provide a continuous spectacle in the main ring during the four days of the Show. While SPACE is a global standard setter for cattle breed events, **10 breeds of sheep and goats** will also be on display.

The “Prim’Holstein France Challenge”

SPACE 2010 has created this new competition for the Prim’Holstein. Like to the first France Challenge, organised in 1998 by Eurogénétique, the best 230 examples of the breed will be at Rennes, selected by the breed associations in the 10 French regions.

The Prim’Holstein programme continues to run over two days. All the animals will compete in the section judging on Wednesday afternoon. The Championships will take place on Thursday afternoon. They will be preceded by the Inter-Regional Challenge, a spectacular event in itself. Thierry Jaton, an international judge from Quebec, will be officiating at SPACE for the first time.

As part of this Prim’Holstein Breed Festival, the bloodline presentations organised by CREA VIA and the auction sale will also be programmed for Thursday afternoon.

National events for the Rouge des Prés and Roussin breeds

Each year, visitors to SPACE can enjoy a national event for a beef breed and one for a sheep breed...

The Rouge des Prés is the breed in focus in the main ring on Tuesday with its breed festival: a national competition featuring breeding stock and bloodline presentations, bringing together the best 90 examples of the breed. The four days of the Show will also provide an opportunity to display the work of the Rouge des Prés Breed Association, notably as regards the Maine-Anjou PDO (AOC Maine-Anjou).

The Roussin Sheep breed association will be organising its special competition on the Tuesday, for the first time at SPACE, featuring 80 animals.

A final show on Friday

As in previous years, **the Normand breed show** is set for Tuesday. The Montbéliard breed competition is programmed for Wednesday and the Pie Rouge presentation for Thursday.

The dairy breeds festival and the beef breeds festival on Friday will enable other breeds to show off their special qualities in inter-regional competitions. **The Show will end on Friday afternoon with a parade of the week's prize-winning animals.**

A continuous display in Hall 1 and 1a

The SPACE livestock presentation programme also provides an opportunity to see all the animals in optimum conditions during all four days. Cattle will be in Hall 1 and sheep in Hall 1a (behind Hall 1).
